

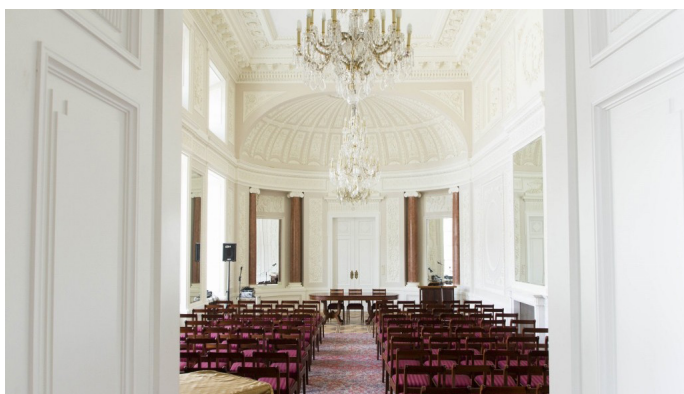
The event will take place at the University of Warsaw, one of the oldest university in Poland, founded on November 19, 1816. Interestingly, it was created by merging previously existing schools, including School of Law and Administrative Sciences, founded in 1808 and whose tradition is followed by the Faculty of Law and Administration at the University of Warsaw. UW is currently the largest university in Poland.



The Columned Hall (20th of April, 17:00)

The Columned Hall (Sala Kolumnowa) is one of the most beautiful, classical interiors in Warsaw. The Hall is located at the Faculty of History. The total area is 375 m² with max. 150 seats. and the dinner will be served in the back of the Hall.

Ballroom at the Tyszkiewicz-Potocki Palace (21st of April, 8:45-17:30, 22nd of April, 9:30-14:00)

Situated on Krakowskie Przedmiescie Street, the Tyszkiewicz-Potocki Palace is regarded as one of the most beautiful neoclassical buildings in Warsaw. The Ball Room features reliefs depicting the Judgment of Paris and the Judgment of Zeus.
